This moratorium applies to the binding of any new business as well as new additions and/or exposure or limit increases to existing policies. We ask that you immediately advise all your agency personnel of this suspension.

**We are **reinstating** binding authority for the following counties in Texas:**

Bee, Brooks, Calhoun, Cameron, Goliad, Hidalgo, Jackson, Jim Wells, Kenedy, Kleberg, Live Oak, Matagorda, Nueces, Polk, Refugio, San Jacinto, San Patricio, Victoria, Wharton, Willacy.

**Binding authority remains suspended for the following counties and parishes**

**LA:** Acadia, Calcasieu, Cameron, Jefferson Davis, Iberia, Lafayette, St Mary, Vermilion

**TX:** Brazoria, Chambers, Fort Bend, Galveston, Hardin, Harris Jasper, Jefferson, Liberty, Newton, Orange, Tyler
