Accomack, Alexandria City, Arlington, Chesapeake, Essex, Fairfax, Fredericksburg City, Gloucester, Hampton City, James City, King George, Isle of Wright, Lancaster,

Mathews, Middlesex, Newport News, Norfolk City, Northampton, Northumberland, Poquoson City, Portsmouth City, Prince William, Richmond City, Stafford, Suffolk, Virginia Beach, Westmoreland, Williamsburg City, York

This moratorium applies to the binding of any new business, as well as new additions and/or exposure or limit increases to existing policies. We ask that you immediately advise all your agency personnel of this suspension.
